

## FOR THE UNINITIATED

YOU CAN VIEW THE PICTURES MANUALLY OR YOU CAN VIEW THEM AS A SLIDE SHOW.

**TO ENTER FULL SCREEN MODE AND START THE SLIDE SHOW - PRESS CTRL+L**

**PRESS THE ESC KEY - TO EXIT THE FULL SCREEN MODE**

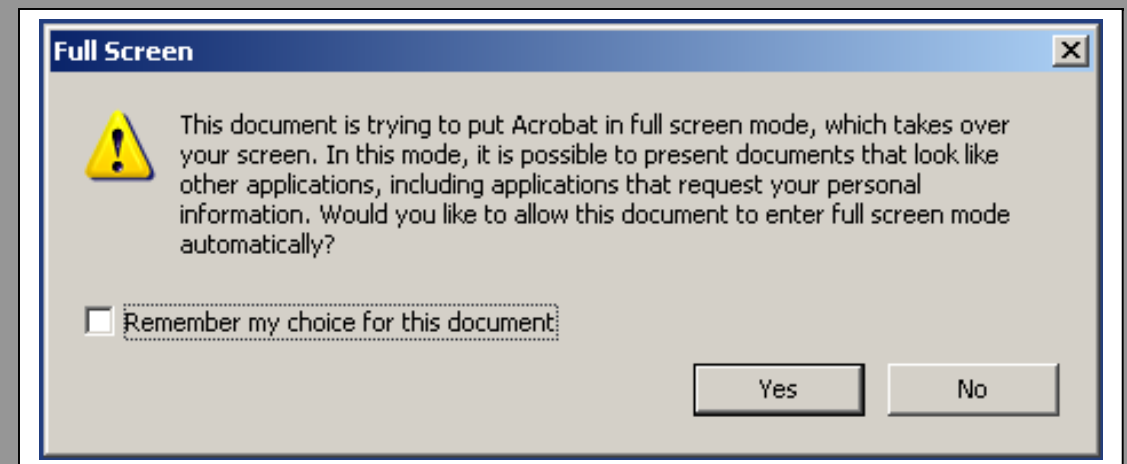
(If you exit full screen mode, press CTRL+L to go back to full screen mode.)

THE SLIDES WILL CYCLE EVERY 5 SECONDS.

YOU CAN ALSO CONTROL THE PAGES MANUALLY WHILE THE SLIDE SHOW IS RUNNING:

- THE LEFT AND RIGHT ARROW KEYS - PAGE FORWARD AND BACKWARDS
- THE DOWN AND UP ARROW KEYS - PAGE FORWARD AND BACKWARDS
- THE LEFT AND RIGHT MOUSE BUTTONS - PAGE FORWARD AND BACKWARDS
- OR USE YOUR SCROLLING WHEEL

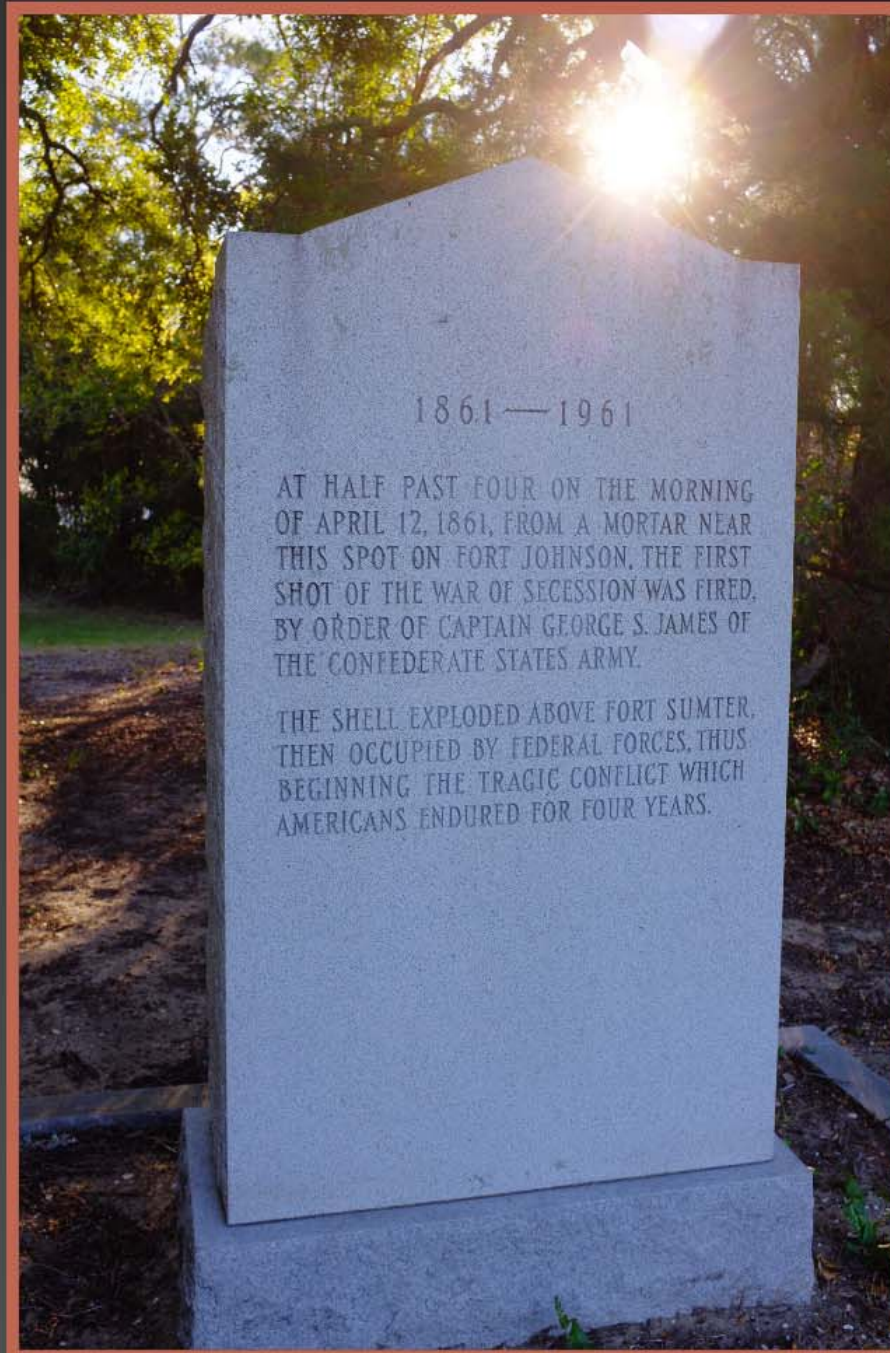

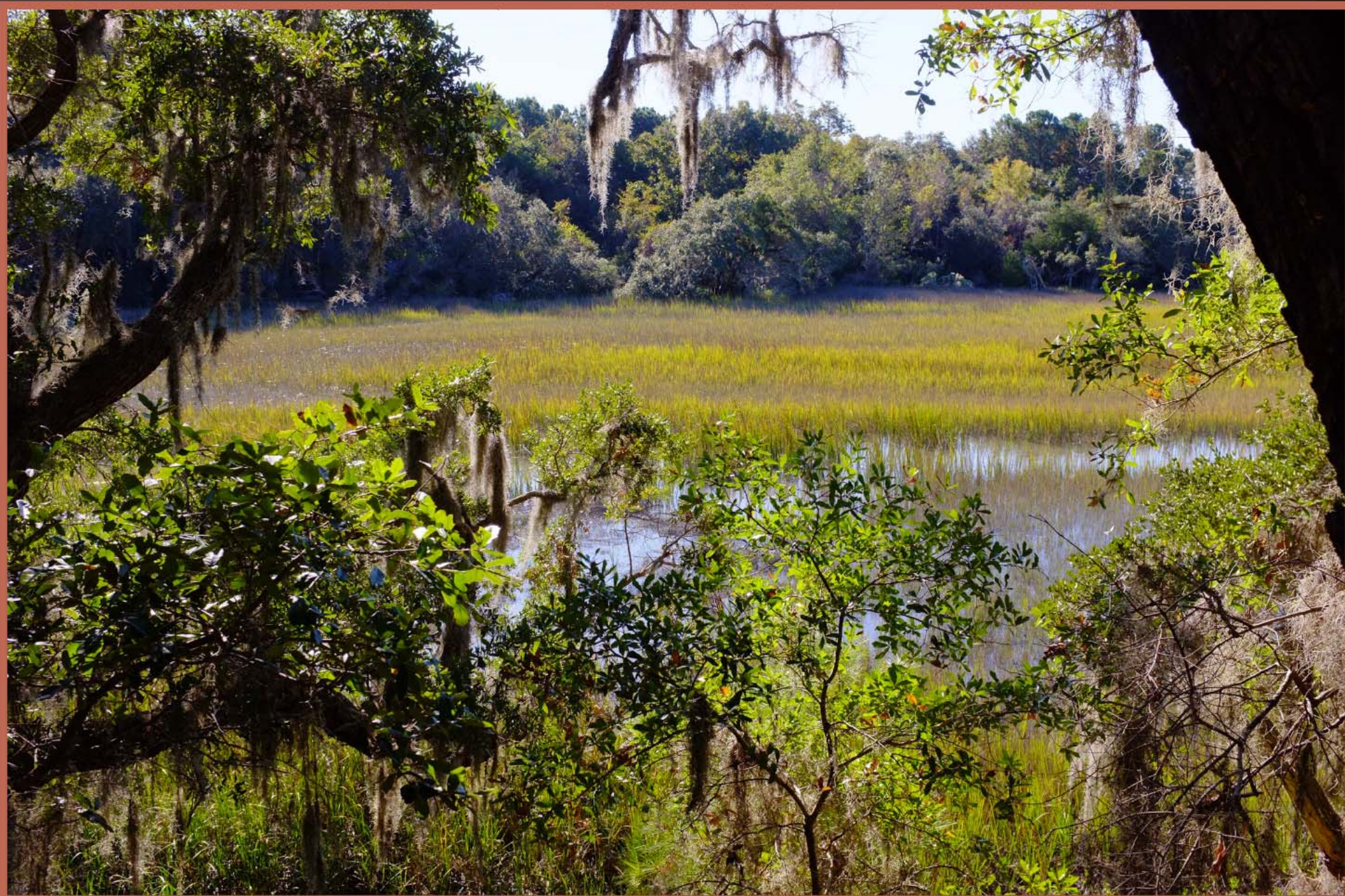
